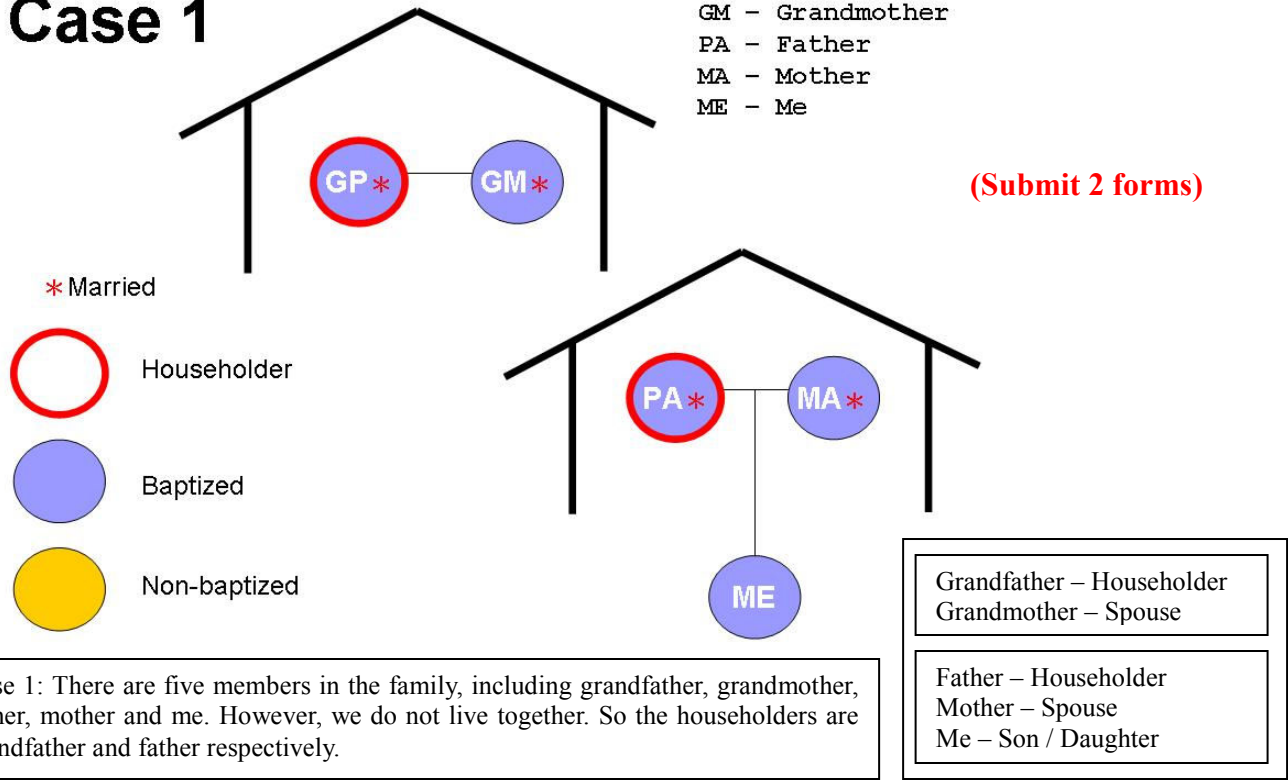


Case 1

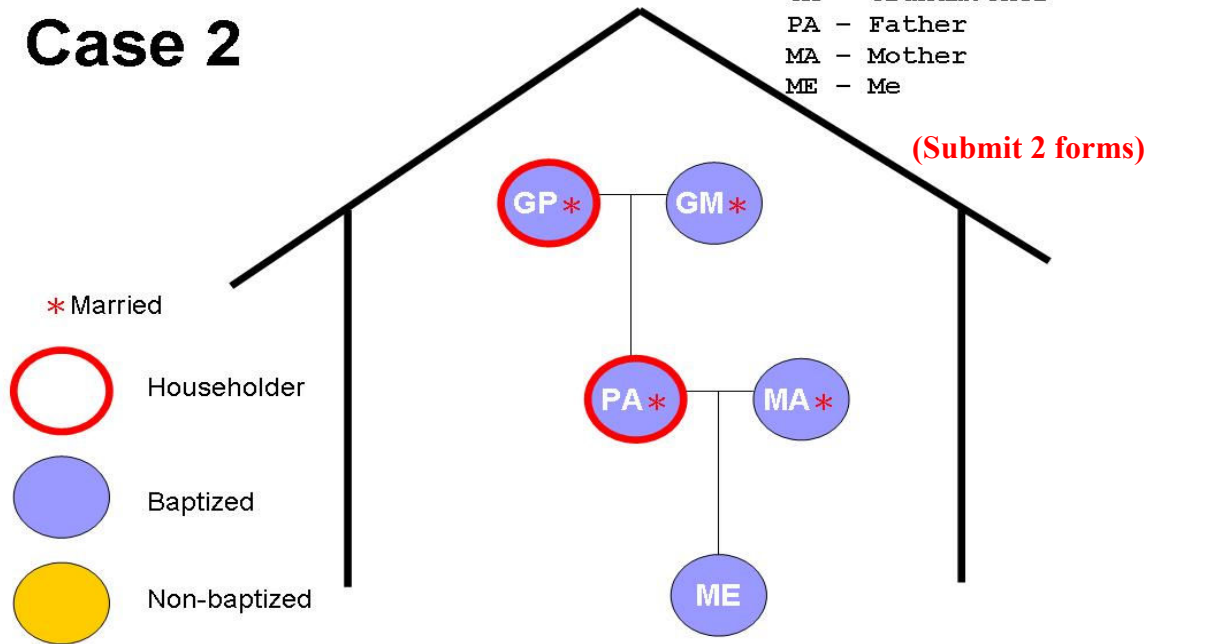

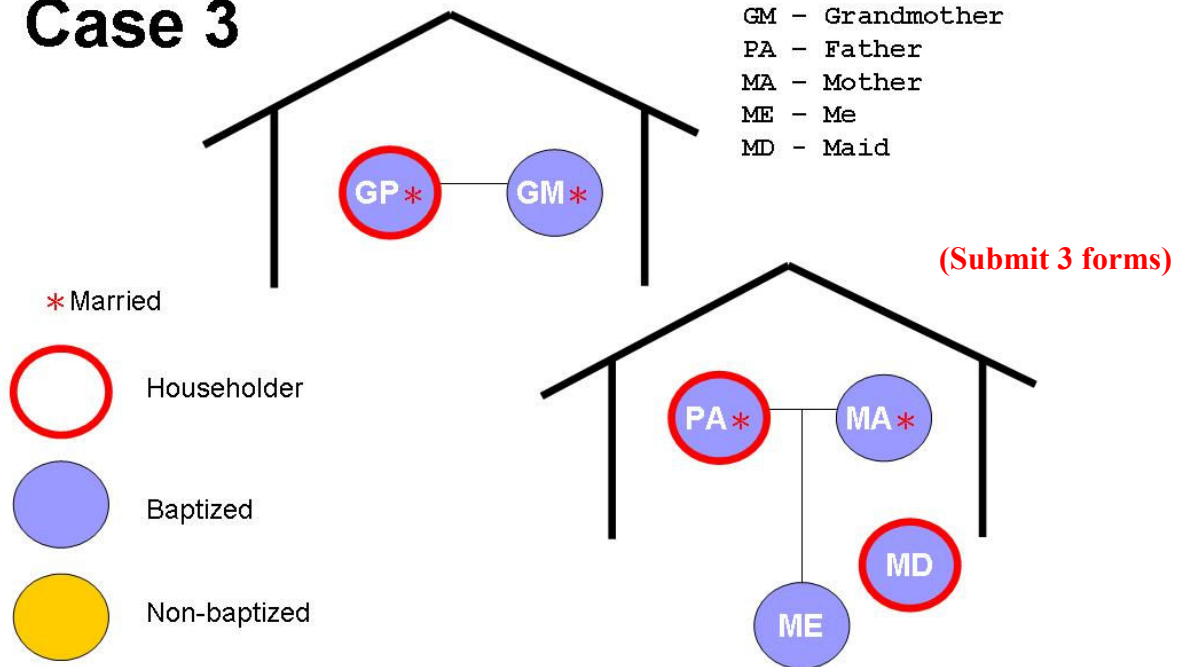


Case 2: Five family members live in the same house. According to the Catholic Family Registration System concept, the father needs to fill in another form because he is married.

 MD - Maid

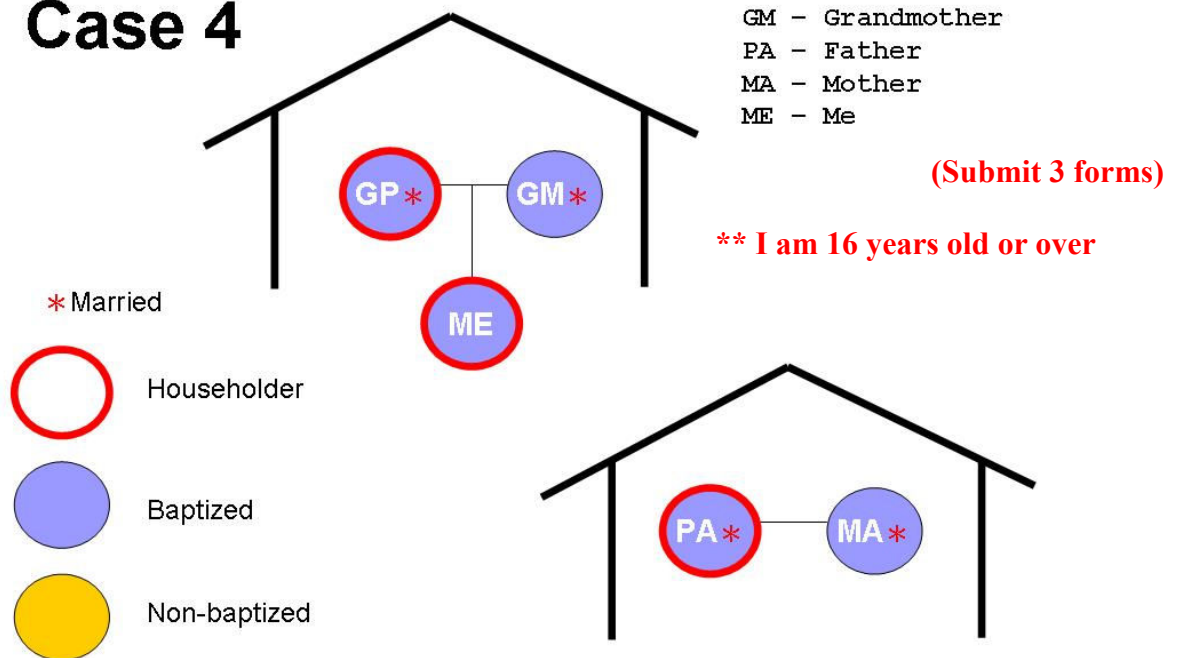


Case 3: There is a housemaid in the family. The family and the housemaid are not related by blood so he / she needs to fill in another form.

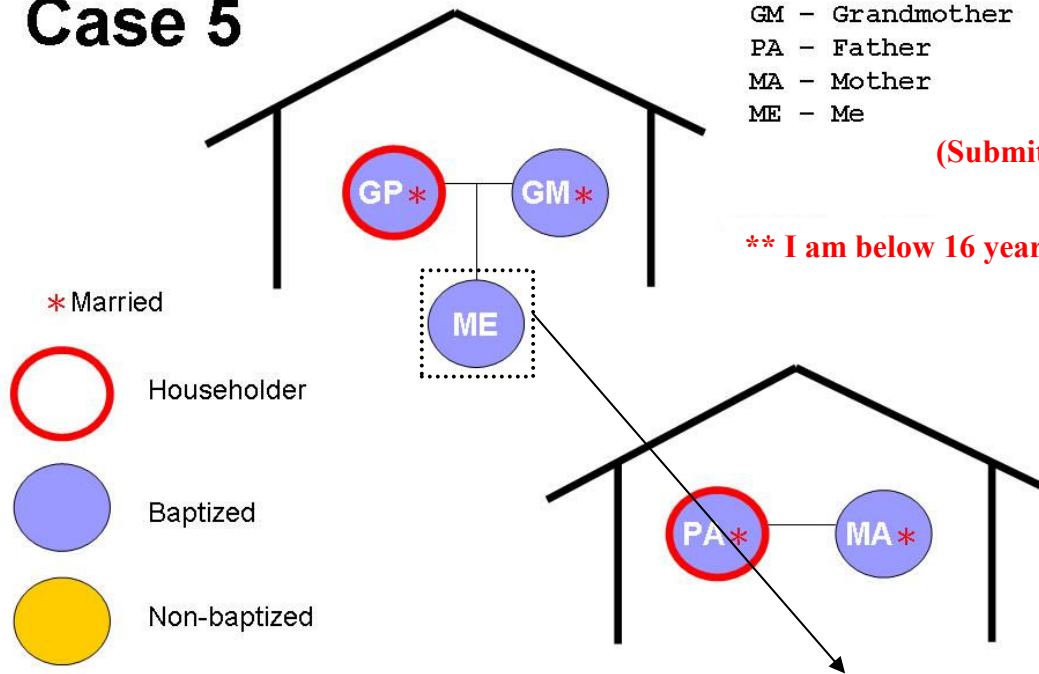
Case 4: I am over the age of 16. I am one of the householders as long as I do not live with my parents.

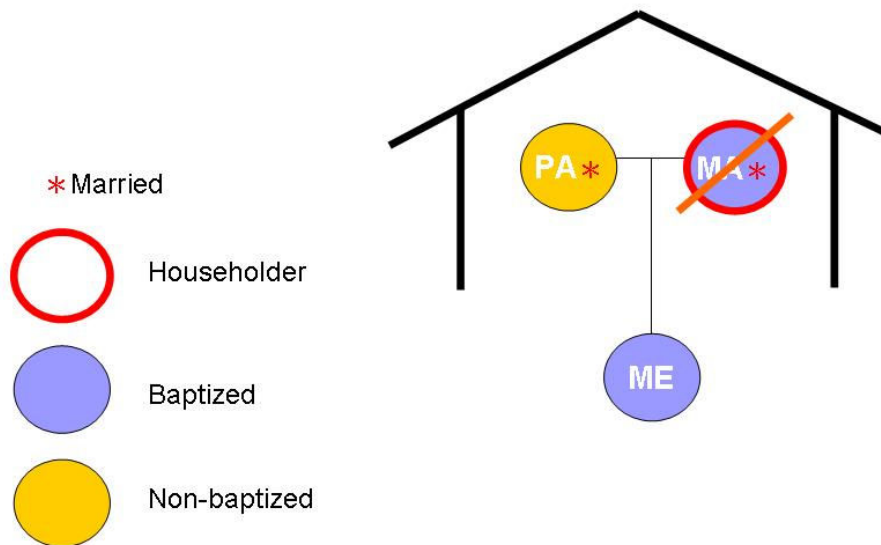
Case 5: I am under the age of 16, my record should to be filled in my parents' form.

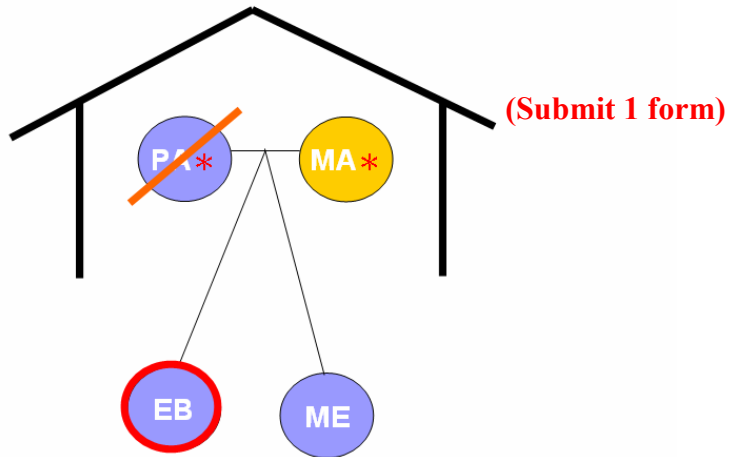
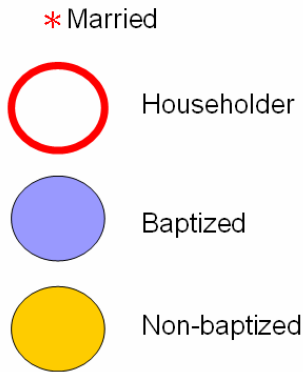

Case 7

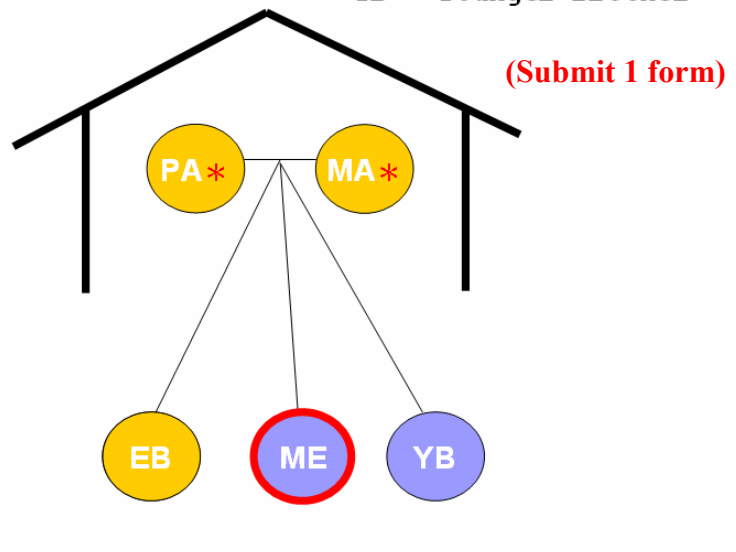
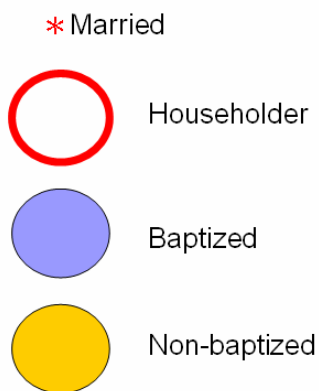
